Since the 1890 Census for Carroll County was destroyed, this will provide a small listing of persons living in the county at that time. Per the Census Bureau, the census was requested by the U.S. Pension Office for Union Veterans and their widows. It allowed Union veterans to help locate comrades to testify in pension claims and determine the number of survivors and widows for pension legislation. Additionally, it will provide a resource as to where in the county the person lived.
